
GLOBAL S.L.P. is a clever evolution of the GLOBALG.AP. standard. An improved continuity that is based on two pillars:

#### **SPECIALIZATION BY TYPE OF ANIMAL**

#### **ANIMAL WELFARE**

Animal welfare is a fundamental part of the 'Integrated Farm Management Standard,' which is at the core of the GLOBAL S.L.P. Standard.

In addition to complying with international regulations, we are aware that it is one of the demands that is growing in importance for consumers. For this reason, by specialising the standard in livestock farming, we have taken into account the particularities of each species, also trying to anticipate future legal and ethical requirements.

In that regard, we have a number of additional voluntary modules designed to go beyond animal welfare legislation and use results-based criteria. These are additional species-focused options that **add a higher level of quality to certification.** 

#### **ANIMAL TRANSPORT**

The conditions of transporting animals have a significant effect on their welfare. The GLOBAL S.L.P. certification **demands the highest standards in this area.** 

The standard **addresses all critical aspects related to the transport of each animal species**, and its requirements incorporate legal guidelines along with best practices recognized and endorsed by professionals throughout the livestock chain.

#### **BASE MODUEL FOR ANIMALS AND SUB-SCOPES**

With the specialization in livestock, the Base Module called 'Livestock Base' has been created. It includes what was included in the GLOBALG.A.P. Base Module and the Livestock Module before the Smart evolution into GLOBAL S.L.P. and the Livestock Module.

From there, there are different sub-modules for each animal species.

### CATTLE AND SHEEP CATTLE

It contains 29 checkpoints, divided into 6 sections:

- FEED, FORAGE
- HOUSING AND FACILITIES
- HYGIENE
- HANDLING

#### **DAIRY**

It has 37 checkpoints divided into 8 sections:

- HOUSING AND FACILITIES
- DAIRY HEALTH
- MILKING
- MILKING FACILITES
- HYGIENE
- CLEANING AGENTS AND OTHER CHEMICALS

### CALVES AND YOUNG BEEF

It has 41 control points divided into 9 sections: Calves / young cattle sections:

# ANIMAL TRANSPORT STANDARD

### ANIMAL WELFARE

It applies to all road vehicle operators transporting animals over 65 km and contract carriers transporting animals over 65 km.

Its content is **the result of a very detailed study and a program developed** after careful consultation with transporters, livestock breeders, animal protection organizations and NGOs around the world.

The standard covers all elements of animal welfare related to the movement of animals, such as ramps, noise, protection against inclement weather, animal density, ventilation, temperature, cleanliness and handling both during transit and at times of loading and unloading. It also addresses species-specific issues, as well as the certification drivers must have

Animal welfare is one of our top priorities. It is an issue that is covered in more than 25% of the control points of our animal production standards and that also maintains a prominent role in all sub-areas.

In addition, it is one of the issues in which we are most attentive to the legal changes that are foreseen, as well as to the requirements

consumer ethics. The aim is always for our technical committees to contemplate the changes that are foreseen and immediately detect those that arise in society, so that the modules of the standard transcend the legal requirements.



# TOWARDS GLOBAL HARMONIZATION

#### **INDICATIONS FOR COMPLIANCE**

All GLOBAL S.L.P. certified producers are registered in our database and identified with a Global Unique Number (GSN). The GSN is on every printed certificate. It is also the online search code to access all the relevant traceability information: the certification body, the standard used, the condition of the product and the validity of the certificate.

For the producer, the GSN is **his passport to the world's markets**. For the retailer, it's the way to ensure that you're dealing with a trusted supplier.

#### HARMONIZATION AND INTEGRITY

We are committed to removing the complexity of the certification process. Our goal is to eliminate duplication of processes and work under the principle of 'one auditor on the farm.'

This is why we strive to harmonize the requirements of the different programs. Wherever possible, we recognize national standards that are equivalent and confer approved or homologated status on them. As a result, **the market can meet its need for food safety** by verifying that have the GLOBAL S.L.P. certification or an approved equivalent standard. Either one is enough to give confidence to the buyer and validate the producer.

#### **ONE HEALTH**

At GLOBAL S.L.P. we are aligned with the One Health concept that recognises the interconnection between human health, animal health and the environment.

Therefore, taking into account this human-animal-environment interface, the standard **is designed to help companies** implement production models that contribute to developing more efficient and effective food safety and public health strategies.

### **TECHNICAL COMMITTEES**

The Smart evolution of the GLOBAL S.L.P. standard begins at the very base of the standard with a key decision: the creation of three committees – pigs, poultry and ruminants – made up of professionals fully involved in the continuous improvement and effectiveness of the standard.

They are the ones who are attentive to the trends and demands of the markets and work to quickly translate these changes into the norm, taking into account the particularities of each subsector.

By specialising technical committees, **the efficiency of their work is increased,** which makes it possible to ensure a continuous updating of the standard that preserves its usefulness.
